- *Video content:* Each group is required to produce a 1-3 minute TikTok video relating to technology aspects of ASEAN Youth in the following outlines:

Opening (~30 seconds)	Providing an intro of ASEAN/ your team/one of ASEAN nations according to your topic OR Tell why you choose the topic to share OR Provide an introduction in any creative way
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ASEAN Gen Tech Discovery	Discover the following technology aspects of ASEAN Youth:
(~120 seconds)	Discover useful technology tips, smart apps in daily life OR Discover the differences of daily habits between various ASEAN students OR Provide the fun facts about ASEAN Gen Tech OR Provide a funny comparison between technology students and others (ex: IT students Vs Social Science students) OR Develop your own creative topics providing ASEAN Gen Tech
Ending (~30 seconds)	Convey a message of ASEAN Gen Tech in various ways: Team dancing/singing OR Team members deliver message to inspire ASEAN friends OR Any creative ending with your team style
