





Industrial University of Tyumen invites young teachers and researchers to participate in the unique educational Project "IUT Summer Institute" under the auspices of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation.

The goal of the IUT Summer Institute project is to expand international relations and involve foreign faculty members and researchers in the scientific and educational environment of Russia through joint research, writing joint scientific articles and implementing joint educational activities.

The project is planned for the period from July 28 to August 10, 2025.

The thematic area of the IUT Summer Institute is **Sustainable Development**: **Technology**, **Ecology**, **Safety**».

Main topics of the Summer Institute

As part of the Summer Institute 2025, IUT experts will cover topics of environmental safety and the impact of oil and gas technogenesis on the hydrosphere of the West Siberian region, talk about sustainable development in the Arctic, and present projects in the field of renewable energy sources along with the new water purification technologies. The program includes lectures and master classes, for example, on developing corporate social responsibility activities. Participants will be shown the "Process Factory" as an innovative platform for the practical application of lean manufacturing tools, where group training will be held.

The program is supplemented by educational tracks organized by IUT partner universities in the cities of Yekaterinburg and Khanty-Mansiysk, as well as by the leading Russian Petrochemical Company, SIBUR (the city of Tobolsk).

The Project language is English.

Participants in the Project are young teachers and researchers under the age of 35 (at the time of the Project); 3 representatives from each participating country. According to the terms of the project, participants should not have experience studying or working in the Russian Federation.

Expenses of participants associated with participation in the Project are fully paid by the host party (IUT). Host costs include the following:

- air travel of participants, including luggage from the place of stay to the Project site and back;
- expenses for visa support for participants (if necessary);
- costs associated with obtaining insurance for participants for the period of the Project;
- costs of providing logistics for participants within the Project;
- expenses for accommodation and food of participants.

The Project program consists of two Modules.

The educational module includes lectures, master classes and practical exercises from teachers and researchers of Industrial University of Tyumen, as well as educational tracks hosted by universities and partner organizations of IUT.

The cultural module introduces Project participants to the culture and values of Russia and includes tours to the sights of the region, visits to museums, exhibitions, various master classes, hospitality evenings and others.

Based on the results of completion of the educational program, the Project participants will be awarded **Certificates** from the IUT and its partner organizations.
